


Over the weekend, we were proud to hold our First Annual First Nat Laundromat day with the **Lynchburg Humane Society!** 


A group of our employees met at LHS to grab lots of dirty laundry, took it to two laundromats and returned clean bedding and supplies for our furry friends! 🐾
